

FIDE REGULATIONS:

Tournament will be conducted as per FIDE laws of chess.

SYSTEM OF PLAY:

Swiss System shall apply

Pairing Software: Swiss Manager

TIME CONTROL:

60 Mins each + 30 Sec increment from move 1

Default Time: 15 Mins

TIE-BREAK:

I. Buchholz Cut 1 II. Buchholz III. Sonneborn-Berger IV. Direct encounter

V. The greater number of wins including forfeits VI. Number of wins with Black pieces. In case of Tie for a prize, the FIDE Tie Break System will be followed. However the prize money will not be shared. A player is eligible to get only one higher prize in this event.

APPEALS COMMITTEE: Before the commencement of the tournament, AICF/ORGANIZERS shall form a five-member Appeals Committee with two reserves. The Appeals Committee's decision will be final and binding for all the players concerned.

PROTESTS: If any, against the decision of the Arbiter or the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 1,000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident to the Appeals Committee. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

DRAW AGREEMENT: The players, over a board, can agree for a draw only after the 30th move of Black

WITHDRAWALS: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing to the Chief Arbiter in writing.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES: During play a player is forbidden to possess any sort of electronic gadgets and wrist watches.

Association reserve the rights to admission in to the venue and the tournament hall.

Identity Card is mandatory for all the players to enter in to the tournament hall.

ACCOMMODATION: Food and Accommodation will be available at the cost of Re1500/- only per person for all the 3 days. Breakfast, Lunch and Supper will be
provided every day. Food will be given from 14-02-2025 morning. The accommodation
is an unfurnished dormitory type. The accommodation will be allowed on a First Come
First Serve basis.
